

SAINT-CIRQ LAPOPIE

DISCOVER THIS HISTORICAL VILLAGE

ENTIRE DAY VISIT



Perched above the Lot River, this medieval village dramatically adjusts to the cliff. Straight out of the Middle Ages, this village, partly classified as a historic monument, can be explored on foot, as if to better soak in the nobility of its architecture, the elegance of its bridges, its stairs, its fortified doors ...

Saint-Cirq Lapopie includes many beautiful old houses which facades of stone or wood were built between XIIIth and XVIth centuries. They are characterised by their steep-sloped, flat tile roofs.

In the streets, open arcades of shops preserve the memory of craft activities that created the wealth of St. Cirq.

Formerly witness to a flourishing boat life, renowned for its woodturners, Saint-Cirq-Lapopie is a listed site comprising 13 historic monuments. The village has retained all of its heritage, but above all an incredible charm.

This trip includes a free visit of the town and its main attractions. Also, a one hour boat trip on the Lot river to discover the "Seven Wonders of Saint Cirq Lapopie", along with its superb landscape and architecture.
